Annunciation of the Lord - March 25, 2026



- Luke 1:26-38
- As we listen to the story of the Annunciation, we once again celebrate Mary's generous and courageous 'Yes' to this startling and disruptive call from God. She chooses openness to God's invitation, no matter the consequences for her life.
- Mary's fiat is given freely, despite the uncertainty of what it will mean, and she never once withdraws that 'Yes'. She continues to hope and trust in God, even in the face of immense suffering, including the heartbreak of her son's crucifixion. In doing so, she shows us how to live a life of hope.
